TILBURY GREEN POWER PROJECT REACHES SIGNIFICANT SAFETY MILESTONE

The Tilbury Green Power (TGP) Project has today achieved a significant safety milestone, having completed 250,000 hours of construction work without any Lost Time Incidents.

Mark Lawlor, TGP's Construction Manager, said "Reaching this significant safety milestone demonstrates the commitment from TGP and all our construction partners, including BWSC and AET, to delivering the highest standards of health and safety management on site. Collectively we promote a safe working culture and climate, and encourage and reward safe behaviour. Our Behavioural Based Safety Programme has also assisted greatly. This Programme seeks to motivate each and every worker to make the right choices and actions for their safety and that of everyone around them".

Notes:

A Lost Time Incident is an accident occurring at work that results in the injured party being at least one full day away from work duties.

Tilbury Green Power Limited is constructing a renewable power plant fuelled by waste wood, within the Port of Tilbury on the banks of the River Thames.

The Plant will have capacity of around 40 megawatts (MW) and will produce up to 319,000 MWh of renewable electricity each year – enough to supply around 97,000 average homes, and will play a valuable role in the UK meeting its target for producing 20% of its energy from renewable sources. The Plant will utilise around 270,000 tonnes of waste wood sourced from the region.

The Tilbury Green Power Plant is being developed by Tilbury Green Power Limited, the major shareholders of which are ESB and the UK Green Investment Bank.
