Today, representatives from Tilbury Green Power's shareholders and construction partners came together for the second site Safety Forum and the launch of our Behavioural Safety Initiative. Attendees included ESB, the UK Green Investment Bank, BWSC, and AET.

The Safety Forum covered the revised safety plans for the construction site, a review of how safety risks can be managed, and a behavioural safety leadership workshop facilitated by Triona Tammemagi from ESB.

In introducing the workshop, Triona emphasised that "Behavioural safety is aimed at motivating each and every worker to make the right choices and actions for their safety and the safety of others. The focus on behavioural safety is a strong sign of our collective commitment to ensure that everybody on site stays safe at all times, and to ensure that we all look out for each others safety."

It was a very successful day which will help to ensure the continued focus and promotion of safety on site as we progress further into construction.

Tilbury Green Power Limited is constructing a renewable power plant fuelled by waste wood, within the Port of Tilbury on the banks of the River Thames.

The Plant will have capacity of around 40 megawatts (MW) and will produce up to 319,000 MWh of renewable electricity each year – enough to supply around 97,000 average homes, and will play a valuable role in the UK meeting its target for producing 20% of its energy from renewable sources. The Plant will utilise around 270,000 tonnes of waste wood sourced from the region.
