TILBURY GREEN POWER LAUNCHES NEW WEBSITE

Tilbury Green Power (TGP) has today launched its new website: www.TilburyGreenPower.com

The new website contains a wide range of information on the project, including background information on the project; details on how the project will operate; and Frequently Asked Questions.

The website also includes details of how local businesses can find out about opportunities to supply goods or services to the project during its constructing or operation, and how local residents can find out about employment opportunities.

The website will be kept up to date with regular news releases and photographs showing the progress of construction.

Details of the TGP Liaison Committee are also presented within the website. The TGP Liaison Committee is a group made up of representatives from local community groups and TGP, with the objective of considering the construction and operation of the project and making reasonable, proportionate and practicable recommendations to TGP where it is felt that improvements could be made in the way the project is constructed or operated.

Mark Lawlor, TGP's Construction Manager, said "Tilbury Green Power's new website will be an important means of communicating project updates and news to the local community and will be regularly updated as we move through construction into commissioning and operation."

Notes:

Tilbury Green Power Limited is constructing a renewable power plant fuelled by waste wood, within the Port of Tilbury on the banks of the River Thames.

The Plant will have capacity of around 40 megawatts (MW) and will produce up to 319,000 MWh of renewable electricity each year – enough to supply around 97,000 average homes, and will play a valuable role in the UK meeting its target for producing 20% of its energy from renewable sources. The Plant will utilise around 270,000 tonnes of waste wood sourced from the region.

The Tilbury Green Power Plant is being developed by Tilbury Green Power Limited, the major shareholders of which are ESB and the Green Investment Bank.
